Upcoming Changes due to HB 1507:

Master Credentials List

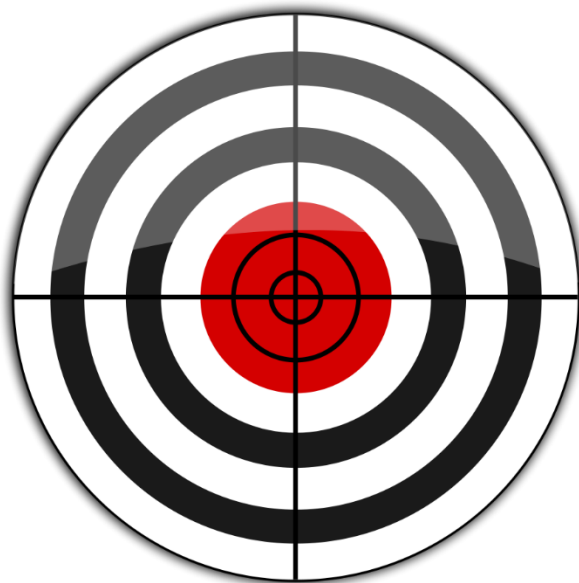
- Includes registered apprenticeship programs, industry certifications, licenses, advanced technical certificates, college credit certificates, career certificates, applied technology diplomas, associate degrees, baccalaureate degrees and graduate degrees.
- For the 2021-2022 school year, the Master Credentials List shall be comprised of the CAPE Industry Certification Funding List and the CAPE Postsecondary Industry Certification Funding List under ss. 1008.44 and 1011.62(1), Florida Statutes (F.S.), and adopted by the State Board of Education before October 1, 2021.

Upcoming Changes due to HB 1507:

Credentials Review Committee

Shall establish a process for:

- Quarterly review and approval of credential applications used to develop the Master Credentials List.
- Annual review of the Master Credentials List.
- Phasing out credentials on the Master Credentials List that no longer meet the framework of quality.
- Designating performance funding eligibility under ss. 1011.80 and 1011.81, F.S., based upon the highest available certification for postsecondary students.
- Beginning with the 2022-2023 school year, the CareerSource Florida State Board shall submit the Master Credentials List to the State Board of Education.

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Employer Expectations of **2-Year** ET Degree Graduates

Basic work ethics & communication, soft skills/customer service

- o Show up on time, be engaged, attention to details
- o Excellent verbal and oral communication skills
- o Know when to communicate
- o Willingness to learn

General programming, network, and cyber security knowledge

Not being afraid of failure

- o Failure in school = bad, failure in R&D = good (you get closer to the answer each time)

Team player

- o Pitch in where you can
- o You don't know it all, even if you do, help someone else learn
- o Put the phone down

Employer Expectations of **4-Year** ET Degree Graduates

Basic understanding of business and how companies leverage them to operate

- Marketing and Sales
- Accounting
- Human Resources
- Technology

Advanced Troubleshooting: People vs Processes vs Culture

- Problems are not always technical
- Know the C-suite Roles: CEO, CFO, COO, CIO, etc
- Company culture: not all companies are equal
- Sometimes ad processes set people up for failure; know the difference

Employer Expectations of **4-Year** ET Degree Graduates (cont'd)

Safety in the Workplace

- OSHA, PPE, Lockout Tag Out
- Production floor vs. back office/environmental safety

Customer Service/Soft (Employability) Skills

- Know your customers and what they need from you
- Know when to use a phone vs email (introvert vs extrovert self awareness)
- Sense of urgency
- You are your brand
- Claim ownership; feel being a partner

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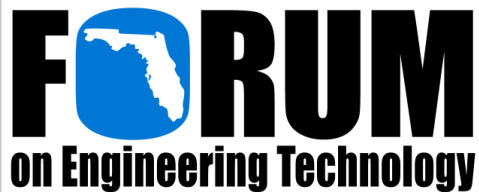
